### AMENITIES

- We are happy to recommend catering resources, musicians, and photographers.
- Catering amenities include refrigerator and approved prep space (no oven or stovetop). We do not provide dinnerware.
- Wi-Fi streaming music and Bluetooth sound system is available.
- Available for event use:
  - 6 long banquet tables
  - 2 short banquet tables (adjustable height)
  - 27 standard folding indoor/outdoor chairs
  - Black linens for the banquet tables
  - 3 outdoor heaters
  - 24 blankets

### POLICIES

- Events require a 2-hour minimum inclusive of 30 minutes before and after event for setup and cleanup. Additional hours based on pricing category.
- All venue rentals require one staff member @ \$18/hour (additional staff required for more than 20 guests).
- Minimum wine purchase is equal to room rental pricing. Club member minimum purchase is based on retail prices.
- Decorations are permitted. No adhesives on painted surfaces.
- Washed, cut florals are permitted (no soil allowed due to the organic nature of the winemaking process).
- Non-wine beverages:
  - Spirits are not permitted in wineries per the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board.
  - Beer & cider are only permitted with a banquet license.

  - Spirits are only allowed for event spaces that do not make or sell alcohol. Wineries are not allowed to have spirits onsite.
